1. By signing and paying the booth fee, you accept and will follow the rules of this contract available online and available in print. Fees are \$8 per day or (\$5 per week) a 5-market pass for \$25. The season is from Thursday, June 2, 2022 to September 29, 2022. This included Food Trucks.
2. Agreements MUST be filled out and signed by the person or persons operating the booth during Market hours. Agreements and payment (payable by cash, check, credit card, or money order to the Northwest New Mexico Arts Council) are accepted on the day of the market.
3. Makers Market Vendor Agreement forms will be available at the market.
4. The Eligibility and Requirements set out in the Market Rules must be followed.
 - a. Seller must provide their own tent, tables and displays, set up and take-down.
 - b. Seller is responsible for collecting any applicable sales tax.
 - c. Food Trucks set up on Orchard Street (closed at 2pm to dusk)
Do not block with personal vehicles.
5. Booth Assignments: Booths will not be assigned for the Downtown Makers Market, it will be first come, first serve. The arts council provides one large canopy tent and vendors cannot set up more than one table, unless they bring their own canopy tent(s) to market. The NWNMAC will schedule you a space at Orchard Park or in a Downtown Business, free of charge, only for special events.
